Cheating is defined as giving or receiving and/or using unauthorized information on a test or submitting duplicate work for individual assignments.

Plagiarism consists of representing another person's ideas or writing as one's own. Copying from a classmate, a text, or the internet is plagiarism. Plagiarism is considered cheating and the student may be subject to disciplinary action.

Consequences for cheating on a major grade assignment:

- 1st Offence - 1 day ISS and a grade of zero
(Student may follow the CHS/ SJHS retest policy)
- 2nd Offence - 2 days ISS and a grade of zero
(Student may follow the CHS/ SJHS retest policy)
- 3rd Offence - 3 days ISS and a grade of zero
(Student may follow the CHS/ SJHS retest policy)

Conroe High and Stockton Junior High School Retest Policy

Students will be allowed 2 full credit retests opportunities per 9 weeks in level classes after remediation with the teacher. Honors and AP classes will be allowed 1 full credit retest opportunity with required remediation. Teachers may also choose to offer test corrections. Both of these intervention practices are used to help ensure learning has taken place after an initial assessment.
