# STOCKTON

## “DRESS CODE HIGHLIGHTS”

THESE ARE NOT ALL OF THE RULES. PLEASE SEE THE STUDENT HANDBOOK FOR MORE INFORMATION.

- ALL BACKPACKS CARRIED BY OUR STUDENTS SHOULD BE MESH OR CLEAR.
- HATS OR HOODIES ARE NOT PERMITTED. THESE ITEMS WILL BE CONFISCATED AND PARENTS WILL BE CALLED. ANY EXCEPTION DUE TO MEDICAL RECOMMENDATION MUST BE APPROVED BY ADMINISTRATION.
- BANDANAS MAY NOT BE WORN AS AN ACCESSORY.

# STOCKTON

## “BEFORE SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS”

- STUDENTS WILL FOLLOW ALL SCHOOL RULES WHILE ON CAMPUS.
- BREAKFAST SHOULD ONLY BE EATEN IN THE CAFETERIA UNLESS PLANNED AND AUTHORIZED BY A TEACHER. ALL TRASH MUST BE THROWN AWAY. (COVID-19 AMENDMENT SLIDE #13)
- STUDENTS WILL EAT BREAKFAST AND THEN GO DIRECTLY TO TUTORIALS.
- STUDENTS WILL NOT ROAM HALLWAYS AT ANY TIME DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.

REASONING: WE VALUE THE TIME WE HAVE OUR STUDENTS ON CAMPUS AND WANT ALL OF OUR STUDENTS TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE TUTORIAL OPPORTUNITIES PROVIDED BY OUR TEACHERS.

# STOCKTON

## “HALLWAY EXPECTATIONS”

- BETWEEN SCHOOL BELLS STUDENTS MUST BE **CONSTANTLY MOVING TO THEIR NEXT CLASS.** STUDENTS WILL BE ON TIME TO CLASS BY **“WALKING WITH A PURPOSE”** THROUGH THE HALLWAYS.
- STUDENTS WILL WALK ON THE **“RIGHT”** SIDE OF THE HALLWAYS TO MAINTAIN CONSISTENT TRAFFIC FLOW.
- STUDENTS SHOULD USE THIS TIME TO GO TO THE RESTROOM AND/OR GET A DRINK OF WATER. **ONLY CLEAR WATER BOTTLES ARE ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF THE CAFETERIA.** (COVID-19 AMENDMENT SLIDE #13)
- ALL **BACKPACKS** CARRIED BY OUR STUDENTS SHOULD BE **MESH OR CLEAR.**
- ANY STUDENT IN OUR HALLS DURING CLASS TIME SHOULD BE CARRYING ONE OF THREE DIFFERENT TYPES OF PASSES. STUDENTS SENT TO THE NURSE SHOULD BE WRITTEN A “CLINIC PASS”. A STUDENT SENT TO THE RESTROOM SHOULD CARRY THE CLASS’S RESTROOM LANYARD. STUDENTS CALLED TO THE OFFICE OR SENT TO ANY OTHER AREA OF THE BUILDING SHOULD HAVE A “STUDENT PASS”.

# STOCKTON

## “RESTROOM PROCEDURES”

- **ONLY ONE STUDENT AT A TIME IS ALLOWED TO GO TO THE RESTROOM FROM A PARTICULAR CLASSROOM.**
- **NO RESTROOM PASSES WILL BE GIVEN THE FIRST OR LAST 10 MINUTES OF THE CLASS PERIOD.**
- **STUDENTS WILL BE GIVEN THE CLASS’S RESTROOM PASS WHICH IS ATTACHED TO A COLORED LANYARD. EACH HALLWAY HAS A DIFFERENT COLORED LANYARD TO REPRESENT THAT HALL. STUDENTS SHOULD GO TO THE RESTROOM IN THEIR DESIGNATED HALLWAY. (COVID-19 AMENDMENT SLIDE #13)**
- **STUDENT’S CELLPHONE SHOULD REMAIN IN THEIR ASSIGNED CLASS’S “PHONE STATION” WHILE USING THE RESTROOM. IF A STUDENT NEEDS TO CALL THEIR PARENT ALL THEY HAVE TO DO IS ASK THEIR TEACHER.**
- **STUDENTS SHOULD UTILIZE THEIR HALLWAY TIME BETWEEN CLASS EXCHANGES TO USE THE RESTROOM AND GET A DRINK OF WATER.**



# STOCKTON

## “ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY”

- THIS POLICY INCLUDES ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES.
- ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE ONLY ALLOWED BEFORE SCHOOL, IN THE CAFETERIA DURING LUNCH, OR WITH A TEACHER’S PERMISSION.
- STUDENT CELLPHONES ARE STORED IN CLASSROOM “CELLPHONE STATIONS”. THIS PROCEDURE IS REFERRED TO AS “STOW AND GO”.
- VIOLATIONS OF THIS POLICY WILL RESULT IN THE ITEM BEING COLLECTED AND TURNED INTO THE AP’S OFFICE.
- STOCKTON JH IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THEFT, DAMAGE, OR LOSS OF PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES. BRINGING THESE ITEMS TO SCHOOL IS A CHOICE.

# **STOCKTON**

## **“CAFETERIA LUNCH EXPECTATIONS”**

### **PROCEDURES:**

- 1. WALK IN AN ORDERLY MANNER TO AND FROM THE CAFETERIA.**
- 2. UPON ARRIVAL AT THE CAFETERIA, STUDENTS ARE TO SIT AT ASSIGNED TABLES. (COVID-19 AMENDMENT SLIDE #13)**
- 3. DO NOT PUSH, BREAK, SAVE PLACES, OR CROWD UP IN THE LINES.**
- 4. TALK AT NORMAL CONVERSATIONAL LEVEL.**
- 5. REMAIN SEATED DURING LUNCH UNTIL RETURNING TO THE CLASSROOM.**
- 6. CLEAN TABLES WHEN FINISHED EATING.**
- 7. RECYCLE ALUMINUM CANS AND PLASTIC BOTTLES.**

### **REASONING:**

**7<sup>TH</sup> AND 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE ARE EMOTIONALLY FOUNDATIONAL YEARS WHERE EVERY STUDENT SHOULD FEEL ACCEPTED AND A PART OF THEIR SCHOOL FAMILY.**

## “1:1 CHROMEBOOK”

### EXPECTATIONS:

1. BRING YOUR CHROMEBOOK CHARGED DAILY
2. BE ON TASK
3. RESPECT THE DISTRICT FILTERS
4. BE RESPONSIBLE

### FAQ:

**CAN I DECORATE MY CHROMEBOOK? No. STICKERS AND PERSONALIZATION ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

**CAN I GET MY CHROMEBOOK REPAIRED SOMEWHERE ELSE? No. ONLY CONROE ISD CAN SERVICE A CONROE ISD CHROMEBOOK.**

**CAN I CLEAN MY SCREEN WITH 409 OR WINDEX? No. ONLY A SOFT CLOTH SHOULD BE USED ON THE SCREEN. IF NECESSARY, STOP BY THE REPAIR CENTER AND THEY WILL ASSIST YOU IN CLEANING IT.**

**CAN I ACCESS THE INTERNET AT HOME? Yes. CHROMEBOOKS CAN JOIN EXISTING WIRELESS NETWORKS.**

**HOW AM I GOING TO GET MY CLASSWORK? THROUGH CANVAS**

**I DON'T HAVE INTERNET AT HOME, WILL I BE ABLE TO USE MY CHROMEBOOK? Yes. YOU'LL BE ABLE TO USE IT TO WORK ON SCHOOLWORK OFFLINE AND WHEN YOU RETURN ON CAMPUS YOU CAN UPLOAD ANY DOCUMENTS AS NECESSARY.**

**WHAT IF I LOSE MY CHARGER? YOU'LL NEED TO PURCHASE A REPLACEMENT CHARGER.**

**WHAT IF I LEAVE STOCKTON? YOU'LL NEED TO RETURN YOUR CHROMEBOOK AND ALL EQUIPMENT TO THE CAMPUS REPAIR CENTER.**

# STOCKTON

## “COVID-19”

### **ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES:**

WE AT STOCKTON HAVE BEEN PROVIDED WITH A NEW BUILDING WITH LARGE HALLWAYS AND LEARNING SPACES. WE FEEL THAT BY FOLLOWING OUR CAMPUS’S “COMMON AREA EXPECTATIONS” ALONG WITH THESE EXTRA COVID-19 GUIDELINES WE CAN HELP PROTECT OUR STUDENT’S AND STAFF’S HEALTH AND SAFETY. THESE EXPECTATIONS ARE ALL OF OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO FOLLOW AND ENFORCE.

**DRESS CODE:** MASKS WILL BE WORN UNLESS A DOCTOR’S NOTE IS ON FILE IN THE FRONT OFFICE.

**BREAKFAST:** STUDENTS WILL PICK UP THEIR GRAB AND GO BREAKFAST AND WALK DIRECTLY TO THEIR HOME ROOM AS SOON AS THEY ARRIVE ON CAMPUS.

**RESTROOM:** COLOR CODED HALLWAY RESTROOM PASSES WILL BE WRITTEN IN PLACE OF OUR LANYARDS SYSTEM.

**WATER BOTTLES:** ALL STUDENTS ARE RECOMMENDED TO BRING CLEAR REFILL WATER BOTTLES TO LIMIT THE USE OF WATER FOUNTAINS.

**CAFETERIA:** STUDENTS WILL BE POSITIONED TO MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING AT ALL TIMES. MASKS WILL BE ONLY REMOVED WHILE EATING.

**1:1 CHROMEBOOK:** STUDENTS WILL BE ASSIGNED A CISD CHROMEBOOK. MAJORITY OF WORK WILL BE COMPLETED VIA CANVAS.

**CLASSROOM:** TEACHERS WILL SPRAY EACH DESK WITH THE DISTRICT PROVIDED CLEANING SOLUTION AT THE END OF EACH CLASS PERIOD FOLLOWING OUR CAMPUS WIDE PROTOCOLS.

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
