“DRESS CODE HIGHLIGHTS”

- DRESSES/SKIRTS AND SHORTS MUST FALL AT LEAST 2” ABOVE THE TOP OF KNEE OR LONGER.
- SHIRT/TOPS WORN WITH LEGGINGS MUST COMPLETELY COVER THE BACK SIDE.

“BEFORE SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS”

- STUDENTS WILL FOLLOW ALL SCHOOL RULES.
- BREAKFAST WILL BE EATEN IN THE CAFETERIA UNLESS PLANNED AND AUTHORIZED BY A TEACHER.
STUDENTS WILL THROW THEIR TRASH AWAY
- STUDENTS WILL EAT BREAKFAST AND THEN GO DIRECTLY TO THEIR HOMEROOM.
- TUTORIALS MUST BE PROACTIVELY PLANNED WITH THE TEACHER OF RECORD . STUDENTS MUST HAVE A PASS FOR MORNING TUTORIALS TO BE RELEASED FROM THEIR HOMEROOM CLASS.
- STUDENTS WILL **NOT** ROAM HALLWAYS AT ANY TIME DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.

REASONING: WE VALUE THE TIME WE HAVE OUR STUDENTS ON CAMPUS AND WANT ALL OF OUR STUDENTS TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE TUTORIAL OPPORTUNITIES PROVIDED BY OUR TEACHERS.

“HALLWAY EXPECTATIONS”

- BETWEEN SCHOOL BELLS STUDENTS MUST BE **CONSTANTLY MOVING TO THEIR NEXT CLASS.** STUDENTS WILL BE ON TIME TO CLASS BY **“WALKING WITH A PURPOSE”** THROUGH THE HALLWAYS.
- STUDENTS WILL WALK ON THE **“RIGHT”** SIDE OF THE HALLWAYS TO MAINTAIN CONSISTENT TRAFFIC FLOW.
- THE MAIN STAIRWELL IS “UP ONLY”. ALL OTHER STAIRWELLS ARE FOR TWO WAY USE.
- STUDENTS SHOULD USE THIS TIME TO GO TO THE RESTROOM AND/OR GET A DRINK OF WATER. **ONLY PERSONAL WATER BOTTLES ARE ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF THE CAFETERIA.**
- ANY STUDENT IN OUR HALLS DURING CLASS TIME SHOULD BE CARRYING ONE OF THREE DIFFERENT TYPES OF PASSES. STUDENTS SENT TO THE NURSE SHOULD BE WRITTEN A “CLINIC PASS”. A STUDENT SENT TO THE RESTROOM SHOULD CARRY THE CLASS’S RESTROOM LANYARD. STUDENTS CALLED TO THE OFFICE OR SENT TO ANY OTHER AREA OF THE BUILDING SHOULD HAVE A “STUDENT PASS”.

STOCKTON

“RESTROOM PROCEDURES”

- **ONLY ONE STUDENT AT A TIME IS ALLOWED TO GO TO THE RESTROOM FROM A PARTICULAR CLASSROOM.**
- **NO RESTROOM PASSES WILL BE GIVEN THE FIRST OR LAST 10 MINUTES OF THE CLASS PERIOD.**
- **STUDENTS WILL BE GIVEN THE CLASS’S RESTROOM PASS WHICH IS ATTACHED TO A COLORED LANYARD. EACH HALLWAY HAS A DIFFERENT COLORED LANYARD TO REPRESENT THAT HALL. STUDENTS SHOULD GO TO THE RESTROOM IN THEIR DESIGNATED HALLWAY.**
- **STUDENT’S CELLPHONE SHOULD REMAIN IN THEIR ASSIGNED CLASS’S “PHONE STATION” WHILE USING THE RESTROOM. IF A STUDENT NEEDS TO CALL THEIR PARENT ALL THEY HAVE TO DO IS ASK THEIR TEACHER.**
- **STUDENTS SHOULD UTILIZE THEIR HALLWAY TIME BETWEEN CLASS EXCHANGES TO USE THE RESTROOM AND GET A DRINK OF WATER.**

“ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY”

- THIS POLICY INCLUDES ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES.
- ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE ONLY ALLOWED BEFORE SCHOOL, IN THE CAFETERIA DURING LUNCH, OR WITH A TEACHER’S PERMISSION.
- STUDENT CELLPHONES ARE STORED IN CLASSROOM “CELLPHONE STATIONS”. THIS PROCEDURE IS REFERRED TO AS “STOW AND GO”.
- VIOLATIONS OF THIS POLICY WILL RESULT IN THE ITEM BEING COLLECTED AND TURNED INTO THE AP’S OFFICE.
- STOCKTON JH IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THEFT, DAMAGE, OR LOSS OF PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES. BRINGING THESE ITEMS TO SCHOOL IS A CHOICE.

“CAFETERIA LUNCH EXPECTATIONS”

PROCEDURES:

- 1. WALK IN AN ORDERLY MANNER TO AND FROM THE CAFETERIA.**
- 2. UPON ARRIVAL AT THE CAFETERIA, STUDENTS ARE TO SIT AT ASSIGNED TABLES.**
- 3. RAISE YOUR HAND TO ASK PERMISSION TO GO THE RESTROOM.**
- 4. TALK AT NORMAL CONVERSATIONAL LEVEL.**
- 5. REMAIN SEATED DURING LUNCH UNTIL RETURNING TO THE CLASSROOM.**
- 6. CLEAN TABLES WHEN FINISHED EATING.**
- 7. RECYCLE ALUMINUM CANS AND PLASTIC BOTTLES.**

CHROMEBOOK GUIDELINES

THE FOCUS OF THE CHROMEBOOK PROGRAM AT STOCKTON JUNIOR HIGH IS TO PREPARE STUDENTS FOR THEIR FUTURE IN A WORLD OF DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY AND INFORMATION. OUR TEACHERS HAVE WORKED TO INTEGRATE THIS TECHNOLOGY INTO THEIR CURRICULUM AND WILL EMPLOY IT WHEN IT IS BENEFICIAL FOR THEIR LESSONS. WHILE CHROMEBOOKS ARE AN IMPORTANT PART OF TEACHING AND LEARNING ON OUR CAMPUS, THEY WILL NOT BE THE SOLE SOURCE OF INSTRUCTION OR ASSESSMENT. STUDENTS WILL CONTINUE TO PARTICIPATE IN REGULAR CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES IN ADDITION TO COMPLETING DIGITAL ASSIGNMENTS. CHROMEBOOKS ARE ALSO NOT MEANT TO BE A DISTRACTION TO TRADITIONAL LEARNING, SO ACCESSING GAMES, VIDEOS, AND WEBSITES UNRELATED TO INSTRUCTIONAL CONTENT DURING THE SCHOOL DAY, MAY RESULT IN THE LOSS OF PRIVILEGES.

WHAT IF I LEAVE STOCKTON?

YOU'LL NEED TO RETURN YOUR CHROMEBOOK TO CAMPUS TECHNOLOGY STAFF. ALL OTHER CHROMEBOOKS WILL BE COLLECTED THROUGH ADVISORY CLASSES AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR.

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
